

Scarborough Swimmers Earn Medals in Regional Championships

Scarborough Swimming Club swimmer Alex Lynn (15) earned Silver and two Bronze Medals at the North Eastern Swimming Championships in Sunderland this month.

Swimming for the first time in the Junior/Senior section, he was pleased with personal best times for all his events.

Amy Corcoran (age 12) also earned herself a silver medal for 100 metre Breaststroke. She swam the race in a personal best time of 1.20.94 beating off stiff competition from swimmers from across the region.

To add to this the young swimmer made finals in the remaining 4 events swum, 200m Freestyle, 100m Fly, 200m breaststroke and 200m Fly.

Also earning places in finals were Scarborough's Jace Cappleman (16) and Joe Kelly (11) who narrowly missed out on podium positions in his two 4th place swims, 200m and 100m Breaststroke.

The club boasted 11 qualifying swimmers and in excess of 40 qualifying swims at this winter's championships, significantly more than any other club in the area.

Club coach Sam Greetham said

"Our swimmers have done well representing their club and our town at this level. They have worked hard preparing for this with many of them training upwards of 14 hours a week. Their reward is to earn personal bests in such a high profile competition."
